Children's Hospital Pyjamas Charity


Thank you to everyone who has already donated to the Pyjamas appeal its not to late to donate collections are being made on Monday 16th October.

Flu Immunisation - online consent



Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating your child also protects vulnerable family members and friends.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have been immunised annually.


Your child will this week have brought home details of the Xmas 4 schools for your personalised Christmas cards and gifts.


