Last week, Year 4 went on a field trip to Leasowe Lighthouse and New Brighton. The children worked hard to observe the impact of pollution at these two locations by the river.

The children designed a tally charts to record their results. When comparing their results, Year 4 found that Leasowe Lighthouse, an area by the river that has more green space, was less impacted by pollution. However, Year 4 observed that New Brighton, an area by the river that is more urbanised was impacted more by pollution but was still a very clean place to visit.
