

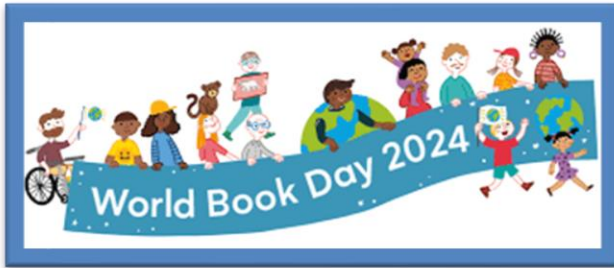

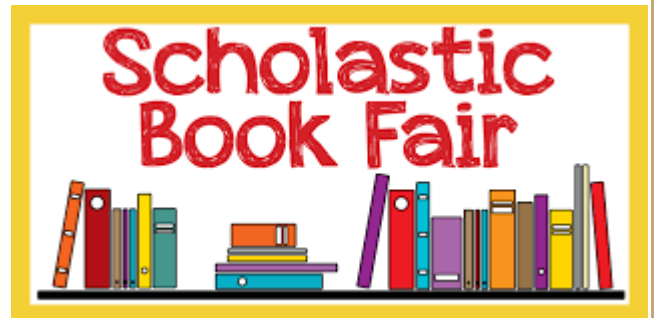
It would be great if children could bring in a copy of the book their character is from and be prepared to talk about why they chose their character.

### Scholastic Book Fair Monday 18<sup>th</sup> – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March

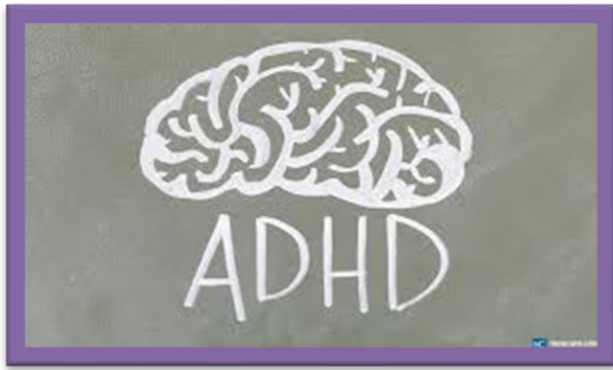
Scholastic book fair will be back at Townfield week commencing Monday 18th March.

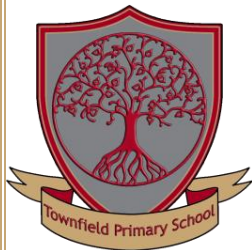

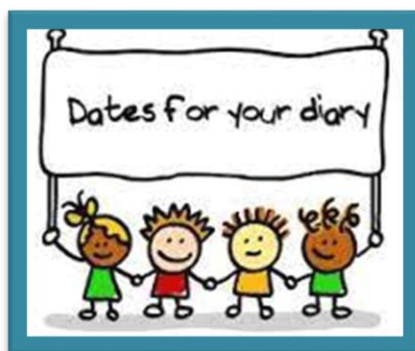
