


Scarlett in 3S earned this medal for playing tag rugby for her team, Parkonians. Well done Scarlett!

We will run our yearly 'Inspirational Sports Day' on Friday 5th July for all classes including nursery. This event has been a huge success the past few years.






We are also fortunate to be able to run a Quidditch Day from Reception children to Year 6 on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July.
